FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

I am having trouble finding information in Blackboard (the online courseroom).

If you need help navigating your courseroom, call Learner Services at [888-216-1667](tel:888-216-1667).

What's the attendance policy?

Regular attendance is expected in order for you to develop the knowledge, skills, and abilities required for the workplace. Attendance for our online students is based on completion of academically related activities such as discussion boards, submission of assignments, and taking tests. Students who are absent for 14 consecutive calendar days (excluding scheduled breaks) are withdrawn from school.

When will my next class start?

Your next course begins immediately after your current course ends. Most courses are five weeks in length.

When do I receive my next set of books?

If you are scheduled to receive books, your next shipment should arrive toward the end of the previous course. There is nothing you need to do other than ensure you complete your work on time and remain in good standing. For courses that utilize digital readings, textbooks are sent in loose leaf format.

Traditional textbooks are sent when you are enrolled in courses that do not utilize digital readings. Readings for Weeks 1 and 2 in courses with traditional textbooks are also available in a PDF format in the courseroom to help you get started.

May I use my books during my online assessments?

We encourage you to use your book to study for assessments and answer assignment questions. Tests are timed so it is important for you to read and study your material prior to taking the assessment.

What should I do if I accidentally start a test?

If you have any issues with your tests, you should contact your assigned instructor in your courseroom. Only your assigned instructor may reset tests and/or allow additional test retakes.

When is my coursework due?

Coursework (discussions, assignments, interactives/modules, and tests) are typically due on a weekly basis during the regularly scheduled course. Every week when you participate in discussions, specifically, you will post a minimum of three (3) times on three (3) different days. Your first response requires that you post a direct response to the three parts of the initial discussion prompt; whereas, other posts are responses to your classmates' or your instructor's posts using the reply prompts provided. It is expected that students will complete weekly initial discussion posts by 11:59 p.m. ET every Wednesday. Your weekly discussion reply prompts, assignments, interactives/modules, and tests are due by 11:59 p.m. ET every Sunday. Please refer to your course syllabus for more details.

How do I complete assignments?

Assignments are completed by uploading a document unless the assignment is in another format. It is important to always follow the direction for each assignment. Examples of supported document types include Word (.doc, .docx), PowerPoint (.ppt, .pptx), Excel (.xls, .xlsx). Assignments should not be submitted via email.

How do I reach my instructor?

Information about how to reach your assigned courseroom instructor by email and/or phone can be found in the Faculty Availability section of each courseroom. Instructors are expected to respond to your message within 24 hours of receipt. You may also call Academic Services to reach an instructor who is a content expert in your subject area for academic help Sunday from 12 p.m. to 9 p.m., Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m., Friday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. ET.
