

## Top 3 Reasons Why You Have No Remaining Funds to Request

## Your financial aid isn't complete and we haven't processed your funding yet.

If you recently started your academic year or completed your financial aid documents, we may be in the process of requesting your funding from the Department of Education. Check out your award letter for more information on the disbursement dates and then check your ledger card in the Puma Den around that time to see if your funding has been processed.

## Your loans are maxed out with your tuition.

Your loan eligibility was determined when you completed your FAFSA and was based on your unique financial situation. The total amount of your funding may have been required to cover your tuition, books and any associated fees, leaving no remaining funds for you to request. You may even require a UMA Loan to cover your costs. You can check this by looking at the award letter you signed or by reviewing your awards in the Puma Den on the Financial Aid tab.

## You previously made a request for the full amount of your remaining eligibility.

Have you made a request for funding to be sent directly to you? You may have used up all of your remaining eligibility in that request.
